BYLAW 11-2016

A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWN OF HIGH PRAIRIE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING FIRE DEPARTMENT, FIRE PROTECTION, AND RESCUE SERVICES IN AND FOR THE TOWN OF HIGH PRAIRIE.

A Bylaw of the Town of High Prairie, in the province of Alberta, authorizing volunteer firefighters to right to the use of flashing green lights in their vehicles.

WHEREAS: by the authority of an amendment to section 59 of the Highway Traffic Act, the council of the Town Of High Prairie, duly assembled enacts as follows:

- A full-time or volunteer firefighter may carry on or in a vehicle, other than an Emergency vehicle, a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light and may operate the lamp if the said vehicle is proceeding to the Firehall for an Emergency call or to the scene of an Emergency.
- 2. No person other than a Fulltime or Volunteer Firefighter shall operate a lamp that produces intermittent flashes of green light.
- 3. Only Green Flashing lights issued by the Fire Department may be used in a personal vehicle operated by a fulltime or volunteer Firefighter.
- Nothing in this section shall be construed so as to permit a fulltime or volunteer firefighter to operate a vehicle in contravention of this act, the regulations or a Municipal Bylaw

This bylaw shall come into effect upon Third and final reading thereof.
